## Geranium Society of Los Angeles

This is a show of the various members of the plant family GERANIACEA, which includes the genera *Pelargonium*, *Geranium*, *Erodium*, *Mondonia* and *Sarcocaulon*.

*Pelargonium* is the most widely grown genus of the family and the one most people call “geraniums”.

Entrants in this show do not compete against each other. Each entry in every class is judged on its own merit, and it is possible for multiple ribbons of the same rank to be awarded in a single class.

Class	Description
1	<i>P. x hortorum</i> , zonals – including stellars, zonal-ivy hybrids showing mostly zonal traits. <i>P. acetosum</i> and <i>P. frutetorum</i> hybrids
2	Fancy leaved zonals
3	Dwarf zonals
4	<i>P. peltatum</i> types, ivy leaved and zonal-ivy hybrids showing mostly ivy characteristics
5	<i>P. domesticum</i> , regals or Lady Washington types -Regular types -Small flowered regals -Angel Pelargoniums
6	Scented leaved, all types except scented <i>Pelargonium</i> species in seed which must be entered in <i>Pelargonium species</i> classes
7	<i>Pelargonium species</i>
8	<i>Geraniaceae</i> other than <i>Pelargonium</i>
9	Any other, including unique-regal hybrids
10	Other Specimens <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Standards (tree form): minimum height of break 24inches above soil level, all types</li> <li>Any landscape feature such as strawberry jar, window box, espalier, etc., standards under 24” to break</li> <li>Planter, dish garden, basket, etc., featuring predominantly members of the geranium family</li> <li>Bonsai</li> <li>Multiple varieties in one planter</li> </ul>
11	Novice entrants/Junior entrants <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any potted specimen in the geranium family grown by an exhibitor not having previously won a blue ribbon.</li> <li>Any entry by an exhibitor in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade or younger</li> </ul>
12	Collections – cut flowers: collection of flowers, each correctly named and labeled
